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### WHY WE DO WHAT WE DO

- Children from low-income homes heard 30 million fewer words by the time they were 3 years old, resulting in vocabularies less than 50% the size of their upper-income peers.
- The average 5 year old from a middle-income home recognizes 22 letters of the alphabet while an average 5 year old from a low-income home recognizes only 9.
- A child from a low-income family enters kindergarten with a listening vocabulary of 3,000 words, compared to 20,000 for their middle income peers.
